Kargil Vijay Diwas :” Remembering the brave hearts who fought fearlessly for our nation!, Saluting the valour and sacrifices of our heroes!”

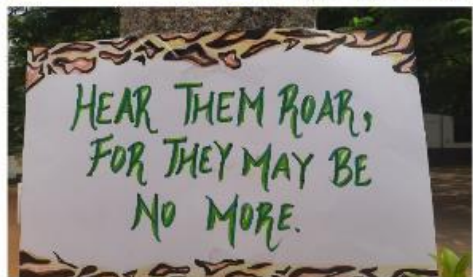

The Principal also addressed the gathering on this occasion.



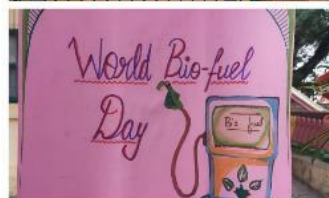
International Tiger's Day: "Don't strip the stripes from nature, Save Tiger"

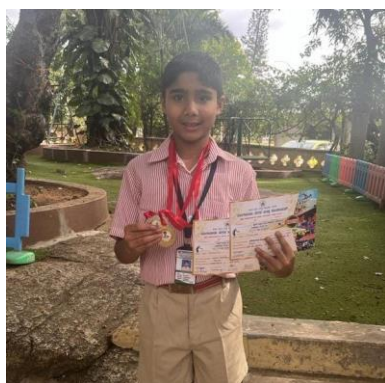
Kaladarpana : Dhriti M won the 2nd prize in Kaladarpana competition. She was awarded a medal and a certificate.

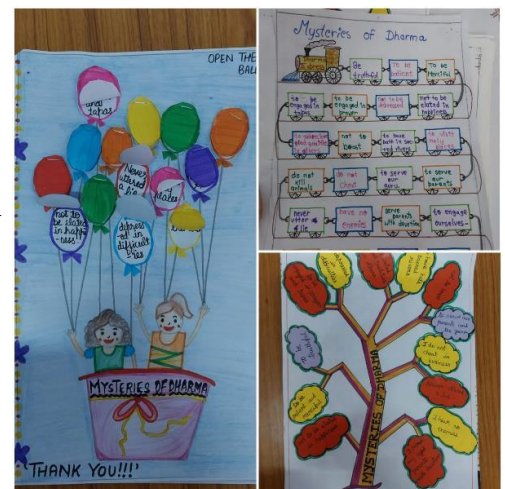

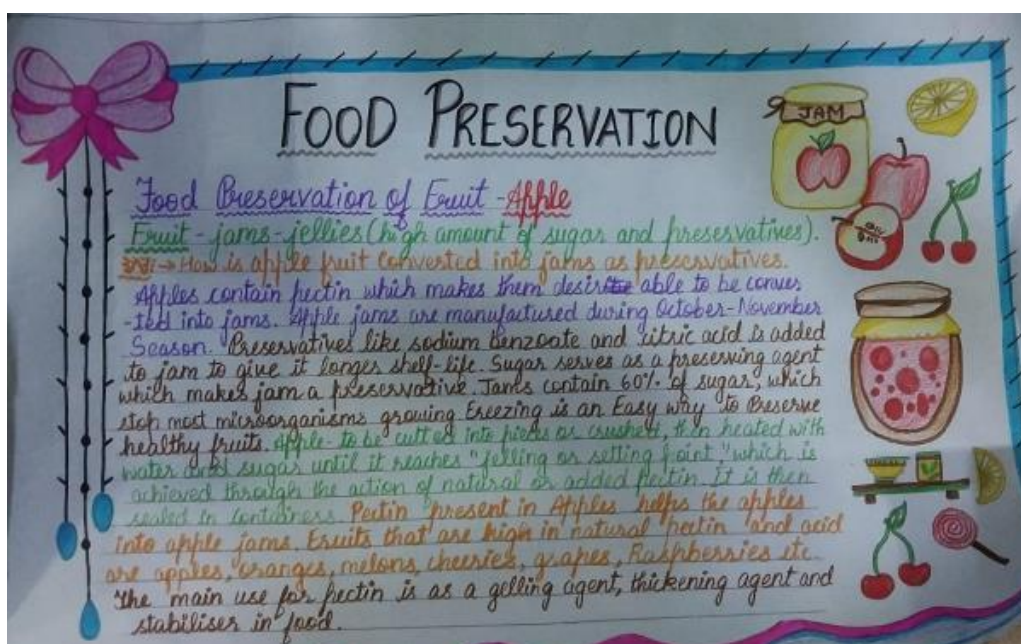
