## **Events and Celebrations**

### **Orientation for Teachers on Technology Integration in Education:**

An orientation program on “Technology Integration in Education” was organized for the teachers on 24th May 2024. It was conducted by IT for Change, a Bengaluru based NGO working in the field of Education since 2011. The sessions started with an introduction to the Free and Open Source Software (FOSS) applications, Open Educational Resources (OER) and their use in teaching-learning. This was followed by a session on creating a digital

‘Concept Map’ using Freeplane where teachers participated by providing their inputs. This was followed by sessions on Story-based Pedagogy and integrating digital technologies in teaching Language, Mathematics and Science. These sessions included demonstrations with exemplars. Teachers had hands-on



practice in the computer lab where they

explored and created concept maps, accessed stories from Story weaver, used resources for Mathematics and Science, and tried out the resources and activities from the Karnataka Open Educational Resources (KOER) portal.

### **World Bicycle Day:**

On June 3<sup>rd</sup> this year, we celebrated World Bicycle Day. It is an initiative



recognized by the United Nations to highlight the critical role of bicycles in sustainable development. At Prasiddhi, a Bicycle rally was conducted, where students of grades



8,9 and 10 took initiative. We cycled and traveled areas of Vasanthnagar, Guttahalli and Malleshwaram with different slogans. The public were inspired and we got a good response. We were assisted by a traffic police officer who acted as a guide and made sure that our students were safe.

### **Introduction of School Bus for Transportation :**

This year the management decided to introduce our very own school transportation facilities. Two buses were introduced for different routes and this venture has proved to be a success. Safety and Security have been prioritized, by using modern facilities



and deploying CCTV cameras. All these facilities ensure that your child/ward reaches school and is back home safely, without any hassle.

### **Orientation Program:**

The orientation program for the parents – a forum was conducted on 01.06.2024. Principal Mrs Radha Gurumurthy shared her experience and knowledge to create an awareness regarding values, academics and activities to be conducted in the academic year 2024-25. Parents appreciated the plans and efforts of the Principal. They were happy about the transport facility being provided for the students. Club activities and Sport activities plan for the year 2024-25 were discussed and the results of 2023-24 SSLC Board Examinations were projected. Parents felt happy about it.

The officials also provided a great insight on how to use of public roads safely and transport by all classes of road users which greatly reduce the accidents. Towards the end, there was a Q/A session where our students asked the officials several interesting and thought-provoking questions. The 78<sup>th</sup> year of Independence was celebrated grandly at Prasiddhi school with great pride and honor. The teachers and students worked together to create a festive and

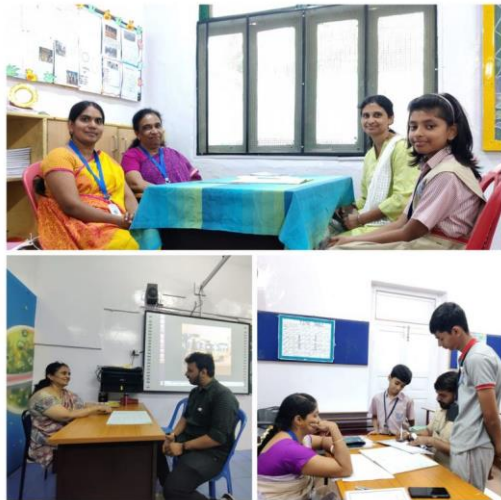

स्वतंत्र देश की पहचान कराने वाले चिन्ह राष्ट्रीय प्रतीक कहलाते हैं।

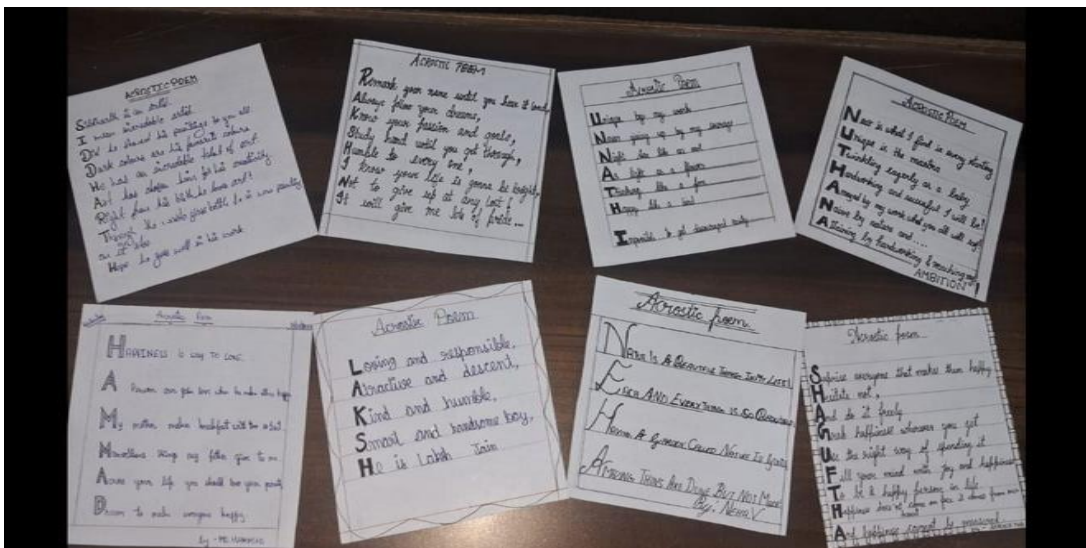
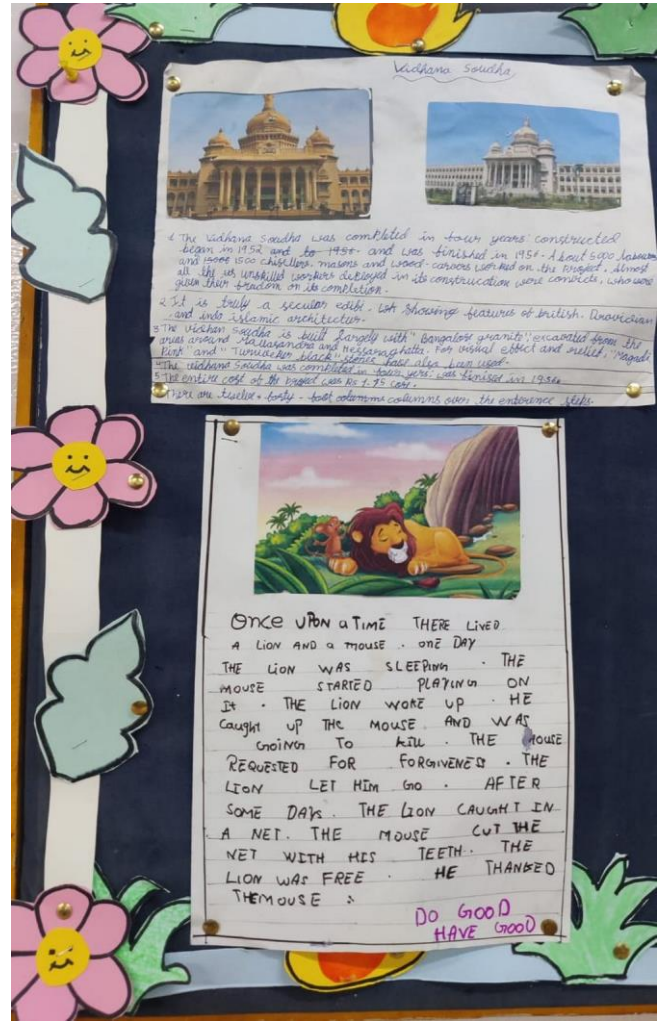
